



## Kristin Kramer, of Groton

June 12, 1945 - May 18, 2026

Groton - Kristin (Sundstrom) Kramer, 80, of Groton, passed away on Monday, May 18, 2026, in the Emerson Hospital in Concord.

Kris was born on June 12, 1945 in Salem, MA, a daughter of the late John E. and Virginia (Hopkins) Sundstrom. She has resided in Groton for the past 30 years. She graduated from Glen Ridge High School, in New Jersey and studied at Ringling School of Art & Design in Florida.

Kris started her career working at Addison Wesley Publishing Co. and then Houghton Mifflin as a text book illustrator. She then obtained her real estate license and worked as a real estate agent at different agencies. She was at Exit Assurance Realty for 25 years.

She was a member of the Groton business association, a director at the Groton Historical Society, Groton Garden Club, and Daughters of the American Revolution.

Kris was invited to the US Olympic shooting team, but women were disallowed from competing in her category, in the International games. She was a member of the Black Hawk Rifle Club, and coached the Randle International Shooting Team at Camp Perry in 2007.

She leaves her husband of 36 years, John I. Petz of Groton; her daughter, Kara Kramer of Hubbardston; a brother, Eric Sundstrom of Colorado Springs, CO; four grandchildren, nephews and nieces.

She is pre-deceased by a daughter, Ashley Kramer, and a granddaughter Jackie Mayer.

Kris's family will receive family and friends on Thursday, June 11, 2026, from 4-7PM in the Anderson Funeral Home, 25 Fitchburg Rd., Ayer. Burial in the Groton Cemetery, will be held at a later date.
