



## Larry C. Anderson

He was born in Clinton, KY on August 29, 1946 a son of the late Ola Lee (Woods) Badger and James Anderson, Sr.

Larry was a veteran of the Vietnam War serving as Sergeant in the U.S. Air Force. He was the recipient of the National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, Air Force Good Conduct Medal, Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal and the Air Force Longevity Service Award. Following his honorable discharge from active duty he went on to serve in the National Guard for several years.

Larry retired in 2002 from the Martin Brower Company in Ayer, where he had worked for over 20 years. Prior to that he worked at George Frost in Shirley and San-Vel in Littleton.

He was a member of the Teamsters Union Local 170, Prince Hall Mason, Jurisdiction of MA – Crispus Attucks Lodge #24 and Order of the Eastern Star, King David Chapter #1.
