TOWNSEND: Lee J. Larson, 90, of West Townsend, died Saturday, May 2, 2020 at Fitchburg Healthcare, Fitchburg.

Lee was born in Lincoln, NH, April 5, 1930, a son of Edwin B. and Doris L. (Davis) Larson and resided most of his life in Townsend.

He was a 1948 graduate of Spaulding Memorial School in Townsend and continued his education at University of Massachusetts in Stockbridge.

He leaves his wife, Cynthia A. (Porter) Larson; Lee's two daughters, Jodi Tapply of Jaffrey, NH, Kari Larson and husband Michael Davis of El Dorado CA; two stepsons, David Freeman of Fitchburg, Tim Freeman of San Pedro CA; three stepdaughters, Rhonda A. Bouvier of Fitchburg, Lori L. Bodanza and husband Todd Bodanza of Tampa, FL, Lisa M. Freeman and Hank Lane of West Townsend; a brother, Doug Larson and wife Mae of Townsend; 13 grandchildren and 8 great grandchildren.

In 1969 he was predeceased by his son, Greg Larson of Townsend and was the brother of the late Bruce Larson of New Hampshire.

Lee had a remarkably interesting and diverse career including his ownership of several Townsend businesses including the Hilltop Hatchery, Barefoot Pools Installation and Service and The Poor Farm Trading Post specializing in sales and service of snowmobiles and ATVs.

He was the founder of the Townsend Snow Blazers Snowmobile Club. He also enjoyed fishing, hunting trips to Sepaq AntiCosti Island, Canada, spending time on his boat moored in Woods Hole as well as trips to his camp in Williamstown, Vermont, and recently taking trips in their motorhome.
