TOWNSEND: Leonard B. "Lenny" Smith, Jr., 61, of Townsend died unexpectedly Saturday, September 7, 2019 at his home in Townsend. Lenny was born in Fitchburg, March 22, 1958, a son of Priscilla M. (King) Smith and the late Leonard B. Smith Sr. and was a lifelong Townsend resident. He was a 1976 graduate of North Middlesex Regional High School in Townsend.
