



## Louis P. DeBlosi

September 12, 1933 - October 8, 2023

West Townsend – Louis P. DeBlosi, 90, of West Townsend passed away on Sunday morning October 8, 2023 in the Edith Nourse Rogers Memorial Veterans Hospital in Bedford.

Louis was born in Portland, ME on September 12, 1933 a son of the late Leo and Emma (Soccocea) DeBlosi Wojcuilewicz.

In 1952 he proudly joined the U.S. Air Force and served honorably until his discharge in 1956. During that time he served in the Korean War.

Louis started his career at Raytheon in Waltham before moving to West Townsend and going to work for the State Highway Department out of their Townsend facility.

He was a life member of the V.F.W. Post 6538 and the American Legion Post 199 of Townsend. He was also a member of The Knights of Columbus Council 317 in Pepperell. Louis was an avid outdoorsman who enjoyed camping and fishing.
