Lucille R. Pelletier, 98, a lifelong resident of Fitchburg, passed away Thursday, April 3, 2025 after a short illness, surrounded by her loving family.

Lucille was born in Fitchburg, February 6, 1927, a daughter of Victor and Anna (Thibodeau) Pelletier. She was one of seven sisters and three brothers, and a devoted daughter to her mother and father, and longtime caregiver to her Aunt Alvina.

Lucille attended St. Joseph grammar school and was a graduate of Fitchburg High School. In her younger years she enjoyed walking, skiing, and ice skating, and was an accomplished seamstress, making many of her own clothes.

Lucille joined the New England Telephone Company in 1945, retiring in 1988 as a supervisor after 43 years of service.

She was a lifelong member of St. Joseph Church, was a daily communicant, and actively participated in many church sponsored activities. Lucille was a member of the St. Ann's Society and the Ladies of Fatima organization. She served as a volunteer with the Montachusett Interfaith Hospitality Network until the age of 90. She lived her life with unwavering faith and devotion to Jesus Christ.

She leaves her brother Robert Pelletier and his wife Dorothy of Fitchburg, and sister Connie McGregor and husband Philip of Naples, Florida. In addition, she leaves several nieces and nephews who were very dear to her.
