ASHBURNHAM: Lucy (Puliafico) Langelier, 72, a resident of Ashburnham for nearly three decades, died Thursday, November 20, 2025 at her residence.

Lucy was born in Fitchburg, April 17, 1953, a daughter of Carmelo A. “Charlie” and Carmela T. (Borbone) Puliafico and grew up in Fitchburg.

She was a 1971 graduate of Fitchburg High School and continued her education at Fitchburg State College.

For 37 years Lucy worked as a social worker for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of Transitional Assistance.

She leaves her husband of 36 years, Richard D. Langelier; her son, Nicholas J. Langelier of Ashburnham; her daughter Elizabeth T. Richardson and her husband, Troy, of Ashburnham; her brother, John Puliafico of Nashua, NH; two sisters, Lena Luongo and her husband, Joseph of Tilton, NH, Mary Roberts and her husband, Charles of Bow, NH; two grandchildren, Spencer Richardson and Finnley Richardson.

Lucy was a communicant of St. Denis Church in Ashburnham. Additionally, she and her husband had been active in the Oakmont Overlook Marching Parent Association. She also enjoyed candlepin bowling.
