November 27, 1935 - May 1, 2023

FITCHBURG - Luigi Iannaccone, 87, of Fitchburg, passed away peacefully on Monday, May 1, 2023 in his home.

He joins his wife of 30 years, Clarisse F. (Trainque), who preceded him in death in June 1992.

Luigi was born in Avellino, Italy, November 27, 1935, one of ten children born to Federico and Annella (Del Franco) Iannaccone. He emigrated to the United States in 1962; and was a member of the congregation at Madonna of the Holy Rosary Church and more recently St. Joseph's Church in Fitchburg. Luigi was an accomplished finished carpenter, enjoyed fixing things around the house and was a "star" at Putnam Street Bowling Alley.
