



## Mae E. (Wyeth) Larson

May 17, 1931 - March 1, 2023

TOWNSEND: Mae E. (Wyeth) Larson, 91, of Townsend died Wednesday, March 1, 2023 at The Highlands, Fitchburg.

Her husband of 68 years, Douglas R. Larson, died in August 2020.

Mae was born in Townsend, May 17, 1931, a daughter of Edison and Alice E. (Smith) Wyeth and was a lifelong Townsend resident. She was a 1949 graduate of Townsend High School.

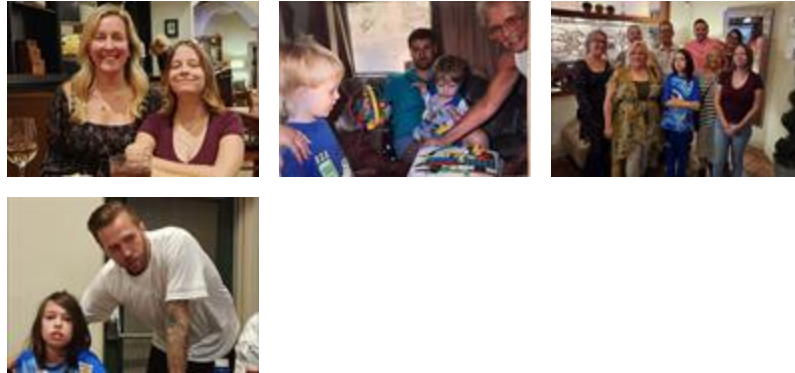
