



Mary L. (Callahan) Guthrie, 88, of Ayer

AYER: Mary L. (Callahan) Guthrie, 88, a longtime Ayer resident, died May 4, 2025 at Ayer Valley Nursing & Rehabilitation Center, Ayer.

Mary was born in Lowell, May 24, 1936, the daughter of Thomas L. and Ruth (Evans) Callahan and spent her early years in Lowell before moving to Ayer.

She was a 1954 graduate of Ayer High School and received her bachelor's degree in education from Fitchburg State College.

For over 30 years Mary taught in the Ayer Public Schools, most notably as a sixth grade teacher at Page Hilltop School before retiring in 1998. She was an accomplished knitter, enjoyed gardening, reading and doing crossword puzzles.

She leaves her daughter and son-in-law, Elizabeth "Betsy" and David Cote of Lunenburg; her son and daughter-in-law, James D. and Debbie Guthrie of Rindge, NH; her son-in-law, Paul Calato of Boston, her brother Francis P. Callahan of Ayer; four grandchildren, Harrison Calato Davis, Cameron Calato, Abigail Cote and Jack Cote.

She is pre-deceased by her daughter, Patricia "Trish" Calato. She was the sister of the late Thomas Callahan, William Callahan and James Callahan.

Her former husband, James Guthrie died in 1994.

Mary's funeral Mass will be celebrated Saturday, May 10, 2025 at 10:00 am at St. Anthony's Church, 14 Phoenix Street, Shirley. Interment will follow at St. Mary's Cemetery, Ayer.
