



## Mary E. Trainor

September 3, 1955 - June 21, 2025

AYER-Mary E. (Boylan) Trainor, 69, of Ayer, passed away surrounded by family on Saturday, June 21, 2025 at Emerson Hospital in Concord after a courageous battle with a brief illness.

Mary was born in Boston, on September 3, 1955, a daughter of the late James and Elizabeth (Carmody) Boylan. Mary grew up in Jamaica Plain and graduated from Mission High in 1973, and resided in Ayer for the past 40 years.
