



## Maurice "Moe" J. Caron

December 29, 1934 - January 10, 2024

FITCHBURG: Maurice "Moe" J. Caron, 89, of Fitchburg, died January 10, 2024 at The Highlands Lifecare Center in Fitchburg. Maurice was born on December 29th, 1934, to Arthur and Parmelia (Sylvestre) Caron in their home on Huron St, or so the story goes. Being born at home 89 years ago included tracking down the doctor on his pinochle game night. This resulted in Moe's birth certificate being dated for the next day and many debates being had for the next 89 years as to when his birthday is.

Maurice is survived by his wife of 63 years Cynthia (Bates) Caron. He leaves his youngest sister Claire (Caron) McNamara and his sister-in-law Theresa (LaBelle) Caron. He leaves 3 children, Richard Caron, of Somerville, MA, Jeffrey Caron and his wife Lisa, of Castle Rock, CO, and Kathryn Bennett and her husband James, of Fitchburg. He also leaves 7 grandchildren, Caitlin Caron of Geneva NY, James Bennett of Goffstown NH, Erik Bennett of Fitchburg, Alexa, Margaret, Jillian, and Christian Caron, all of Castle Rock, CO. He also leaves 2 great-grandchildren, Mila and Christopher Bennett of Fitchburg.

Maurice is predeceased by his parents, and his siblings Roland, Lucille (Spooner), Bertrand, Theresa Caron.

Maurice attended LaSalette Seminary school in Enfield for 3 years and then graduated from St. Bernard's High School in Fitchburg in 1953. Moe started

his career with his own contracting business, building many homes in the city. Maurice received a Bachelor's Degree from Northeastern University, and then a Masters in Civil Engineering from University of Massachusetts Lowell. He worked as an engineer for the City of Fitchburg water department for several years as well as an engineer and engineer consultant for other companies. Maurice semi-retired and worked part time at Romano's Market for 10 years, becoming widely known and loved. He finally retired at the age of 80.

Maurice was known for his talented carpentry skills, using them to remodel their 100 year old house into a beautiful home. It was often joked that he couldn't be left alone or there would be a wall missing. Moe was also known for his love of dogs. He and his wife owned 14 dogs over the years, primarily Cocker Spaniels. Moe loved spending time with his family. He loved working with his hands inside and outside and would always be found working on one project or another.
