Mike was born in Fitchburg, August 14, 1950, a son of Alden and Theresa (Gravelle) Keefe and was a lifelong Townsend resident. He attended North Middlesex Regional High School in Townsend for several years but ultimately graduated from Lunenburg High School in 1968.

After graduating from high school, Mike served his country for four years in the United States Navy.

Mike was employed as a tree worker for the Asplundh Company. Prior to that he worked at New England Business Corporation and Elsa Williams Company both in Townsend and the Eusey Press in Leominster.

An accomplished guitarist, Mike played both as a solo act and in several area bands. While playing alone he was known as “ohnonothimagain”.

He leaves his sister and brother in law, Linda K. and Billy Amadon of New Ipswich, NH; his step grandson, Zachary Racicot and several nieces and nephews.

He was predeceased by his brother, Kenneth Keefe of Panama City Beach, Florida.
