



Nancy M. Arciprete Cieri

July 22, 1941 - June 23, 2022

LUNENBURG- Nancy M. (Scott) Arciprete Cieri, 80, of Lunenburg, passed away on Thursday, June 23, 2022 surrounded by her loving family.

Nancy was born in Boston, on July 22, 1941, a daughter of the late Richard and Margaret (Danckert) Scott and grew up in West Roxbury. She graduated from Roslindale High School and the former Holliston Jr. College. Nancy had resided in Natick for many years before moving to Lunenburg in 1977.

She worked as a respiratory therapist at UMass Medical and later at Burbank Hospital for several years prior to her retirement.

Nancy enjoyed many things in her life. She was an avid Boston sports fan, especially her beloved Red Sox. She never missed a game. When she wasn't watching a game, you could find Nancy reading or baking her famous frosted sugar cookies that her family came to love and expect for every holiday and occasion. These cookies became a staple across every New England college campus and were fan favorites at all the cookie swaps. This was a past time of hers that she enjoyed sharing with her children and grandchildren. She loved attending book club, playing mahjong with her friends, her Women's Guild meetings, attending all of her grandchildren's events, and going to the beach, especially in her adopted town of Venice, Florida. Nancy is most well known, however, for her active engagement in her local parish, Saint Boniface

in Lunenburg. She was a Eucharistic Minister, Lector, a Deacon's wife, and most importantly a friendly and welcoming face to anyone that joined that community. Her presence will be missed in those pews.

Her first husband, Richard Arciprete died in 1973 and her second husband Deacon Joseph Cieri died in 2004. She leaves three sons, J. Scott Arciprete of Lunenburg, James R. Arciprete and his wife Carrie of Fitchburg and Christopher Cieri and his wife Jamie, of Round Rock, TX; two daughters, Beth A. Stoddard and her husband John of East Lyme, CT and Jodi M. Price and her husband Russ of Marstons Mills; a brother, Hugh Scott and his wife Beverly of West Boylston; a sister, Mary Parker and her husband Richard of Kennebunk, ME; fourteen grandchildren, Catherine, Harrison, Olivia, Megan, Allison, Sam, Vincenzo, Elena, Sophia, Rocco, Lucia, Logan, Joseph and Carson and several nephews and nieces.

She is predeceased by a daughter, Robin E. Horton and her husband Douglas, who died in 1994; a daughter-in-law, Kelly A. Arciprete who died in 2015 and two brothers, Robert Scott and Richard Scott.

Her funeral Mass will be celebrated on Friday, July 1, at 10 AM in St. Boniface Church, 817 Mass Ave. Burial will be in the North Cemetery. Calling hours will be held on Thursday, June 30, from 4-7PM in the Anderson Funeral Home, 25 Fitchburg Rd., (Rte 2A), Ayer.

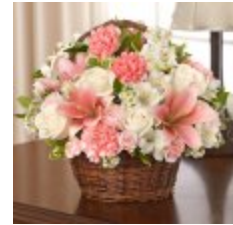
