



Noel O. (O'Neill) Babin

Pepperell - Noel (O'Neill) Babin, 85, of Laconia, NH, formerly of Pepperell, MA passed away on January 13, 2021, at St. Francis Rehabilitation and Nursing Center, Laconia. NH.

Noel was born in Wayland, MA December 25, 1935, a daughter of Edward J. and Anna (Herendeen) O'Neill. Noel raised her family in Pepperell, MA before relocating to Stewart, FL, Aiken, SC, and finally settling in Laconia, NH to be close to family.

Noel is survived by her children Dorie Babin of Broomfield, CO, David Babin and his wife Janet of Pepperell, MA and Alton Bay, NH, Karen Blake and her husband Steve of Ramer, TN, Kenneth Babin of New Ipswich, NH; her brothers and sisters in law, Edward and Judy O'Neill of PA, Terry and Mary O'Neill of FL, Diane and Joe DesRochers of FL; 11 grandchildren and 7 great-grandchildren with one on the way.

After marrying the love of her life Maunsell, she raised her family and ran a horse farm at their home in Pepperell, MA where she bred horses, taught horsemanship, and provided horseback riding lessons to students of all levels and ages who adored her. Noel, in her spare time, enjoyed painting, collecting antiques, and breeding German Shepherds. She was a friendly, outgoing, hardworking, determined individual of a woman and a pillar of her community.

A beloved wife, mother, sister, grandmother, great-grandmother, animal lover, talented artist, and a friend of many, her legacy will forever live on through those who knew her and loved her.
