FITCHBURG: Norman J. LeBlanc, 79, of Fitchburg, died Tuesday, June 7, 2022, at his home.

Norman was born in Fitchburg, October 12, 1942, one of nine children born to Hilaire and Alma (LeBlanc) LeBlanc and was a lifelong resident of the city.

Norman graduated from St. Bernard's Central Catholic High School in 1960. He continued his education by receiving a bachelor's degree from The College of the Holy Cross in Worcester, then receiving a master's degree in Business from Clark University in Worcester and then a second master's Degree in Taxation from Bentley College in Waltham.

Norman was City Auditor for the city of Fitchburg for ten years and then went on to a successful thirty-five year career as a Certified Public Accountant at his own firm in Fitchburg.

Throughout his life Norman remained active in his community by serving fifty years on the City of Fitchburg Retirement Board and as Treasurer of the St. Vincent de Paul Society. He served as a member of St. Joseph's Parish Finance Committee. He also served as the Treasurer to the Montachusett Regional School, as a board member of the Cleghorn Neighborhood Center and was a member of the Knights of Columbus.

Norman loved eating out, reading, and traveling with his family, especially to Disneyworld. He had a strong faith and was a member of St. Joseph's Church in Fitchburg.

Norman was a devoted husband and loving father. He is survived by his wife of 58 years, Annette M.E. (Robichaud) LeBlanc; his son, Mark D. LeBlanc of Westminster; his daughter, Lisa M. LeBlanc of Fitchburg; his sister, Claire M. Boudreau of Fitchburg and his sister in law, Claire LeBlanc of Leominster. He also leaves many nieces and nephews.

Norman was the brother of the late Emile J. LeBlanc, Gerard LeBlanc, Robert J. LeBlanc, Alfred J. LeBlanc, Annette M. LeBlanc, Theresa M. LeBlanc and Pauline M. LeBlanc.

A funeral Mass will be celebrated 10 AM Saturday, June 11, 2022, at St. Joseph's Church, 49 Woodland Street, Fitchburg. Burial will be in the parish cemetery.
