



Peter Charles Boyle Sr.

July 26, 1940 - October 18, 2023

SHIRLEY: Peter C. Boyle, Sr., 83, a longtime resident of Third Street in Ayer and Oak Hollow Farm in Shirley, died Wednesday, October 18, 2023 at University of Massachusetts – Memorial Hospital, Worcester.

Peter was born in Groton, July 26, 1940, a son of Joseph and Helen (O'Brian) Boyle and grew up in Groton and Ayer. He was a 1958 graduate of Notre Dame High School in Fitchburg.

Following his graduation from high school, Peter enlisted in and served in the United States Navy. Peter was an avid scuba diver and served as a scuba instructor. Peter enjoyed coaching the Ayer Beavers Hockey Team, hosting gymkhanas and trail rides out of Oak Hollow Farm in Shirley. He also enjoyed camping, horseback riding and spending time with his grandchildren. He was a member of St. Anthony's Church in Shirley.

For over 30 years Peter held the position of manager at the Fort Devens Bowling Lanes, retiring in 1995. Following his retirement Peter drove school buses for the Ayer/Shirley School District and also assisted in the maintenance of Salisbury State Park where he enjoyed camping with his family for many years.

Peter leaves his his daughter and son in law Kimberly A. and Scott McNulty of

Shirley; his son Peter C. Boyle, Jr. and his wife, Michelle of Colorado Springs, Colorado; granddaughter Shannon Stevens, husband Daniel Stevens and great grandchild Russell Stevens, granddaughter Sarah Landry, husband Douglas Landry and great grandchildren Wyatt and Charlotte Landry, granddaughter April Boyle, granddaughter Tori Clark, husband Richard Clark, and great grandchild Arlo Clark, and granddaughter Tanna Boyle.

His wife, Joan Marie (Davan) Boyle, died in 2013. He was the brother of the late Richard Boyle of New Mexico and Donald Boyle of San Diego, CA.
