ATHOL: Regina "Nina" (Seufferheld) Miconi, 66, of Athol, formerly of Philadelphia, PA, died Sunday, December 23, 2018 at Heywood Memorial Hospital, Gardner.

Nina was born in Mendoza, Argentina, November 2, 1952, the daughter of Werner Seufferheld and Gisela W. (Wehrhan) Christian and resided nearly 40 years in Philadelphia before moving to Athol 12 years ago.

She had worked as an Administrative Social Worker. She was a member of the National Social Workers Association; Massachusetts Governor's Board for Domestic Violence and was a devout atheist.

She leaves her daughter, Angela Miconi of Arlington, TX; her brother, Robert Seufferheld of Portland, OR; Her stepfather, John W. Christian of Ashburnham and her former husband, Joseph T. Miconi.

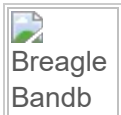
