Mr. Koivu was born in Fitchburg, March 6, 1932, a son of Ernest N. and Aino H. (Etelemaki) Koivu, and was a lifelong Townsend resident. He was a 1950 graduate of Townsend High School.

From 1952 -1954, during the Korean Conflict, Mr. Koivu served his country in combat with the United States Army where he attained the rank of Sergeant.

He was a life member of the Townsend VFW and American Legion Posts.

For sixty one years he owned and operated Country Auto Service in West Townsend. He was an avid motorcycle racing competitor racing in Daytona, Watkins Glen, Laconia and Langhorn. He attended the First Baptist Church in West Townsend.

He leaves two sons and daughters in law, Richard E. and Annmarie Koivu of West Townsend, Ronald E. and Debra Koivu of Pepperell; a daughter, Sally A. Koivu and her partner, Louis Kiklis of Townsend; a sister, Marilyn L.
