SHIRLEY: Robert M. Graham, Sr., 83, a Shirley resident for over fifteen years, formerly of Providence, North Providence, RI and Fall River died Tuesday, December 10, 2019 at Nashoba Valley Medical Center, Ayer.

Mr. Graham was born in Providence, RI, November 26, 1936, a son of Harold M. and Catherine R. (Shierson) Graham and grew up in Providence and North Providence, Rhode Island. He was a graduate of LaSalle Academy in Providence and continued his education at Wentworth Institute in Boston and later received his Bachelors and Master Degrees from Providence College.

During the Vietnam War Mr. Graham served his country in the United States Marines as a Medivac Pilot, attaining the rank of Major.

For over thirty years, he taught History and English at Smithfield High School retiring in 2001.

An avid gardener, he enjoyed working in his flower garden. He was a communicant of St. Anthony's Church in Shirley.

He leaves his wife of 24 years, Patricia C. Selleck-Graham; Kevin Graham of Providence; four daughters, Cheryl Deloreto and her husband David; Kelly Franchetti; Kristin Graham all of North Providence, Bonnie Jean Thomas of Fall River; his daughter in law, Jill Graham of Norwalk, CT; his brother and

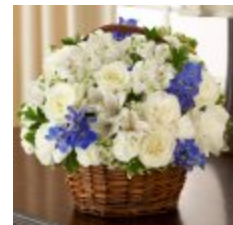

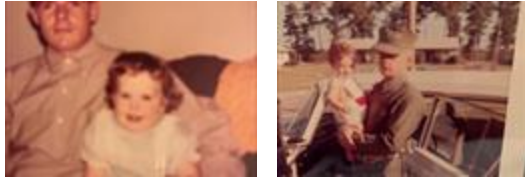
