LEOMINSTER; Robert E. Lyle, 85, of Leominster, formerly of Fitchburg, died January 24, 2019 after a courageous battle with cancer.

Born in Lexington, VA on July 6, 1933, he was the son of the late Austin and Louise (Carpenter) Lyle. He leaves his best friend and loving wife of 41 years, Barbara (Bebick) Smith Lyle. He served in the United States Army during the Korean Conflict, retiring after 11 years. He served as president of the local #60 at Foster Grant and was a member of the 25 Year Club.
