

## Robert H. Ouellette

ASHBURNHAM: Robert H. Ouellette, 71, of Ashburnham, formerly of Fitchburg, died Saturday, December 21, 2019 at his home.

Bob was born in Fitchburg, May 26, 1948, the son of Rita F. (Bourque) Ouellette and the late Frank R. Ouellette and resided in Fitchburg before moving to Ashburnham twenty years ago.

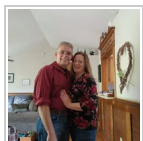

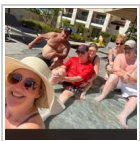
