FITCHBURG – Roger D. Leger, 86, of Fitchburg, passed away peacefully on Thursday, May 29, 2025, at HealthAlliance Hospital in Leominster.

Born in Fitchburg on August 13, 1938, he was the son of the late Alfred and Valida (Roy) Legere. A 1956 graduate of St. Bernard's High School, Roger went on to serve proudly in the United States Air Force during both the Korean and Vietnam Wars.
