Ronan Leon Jeannotte – Maker of Music, Moments and Mayhem (2003-2021)

Ronan Jeannotte, 17, of Maynard, Massachusetts, succumbed to his battle with addiction on September 4, 2021. He was a gifted musician and songwriter, fiercely loyal friend and family member, and proud participant in the fellowship of recovery. Ronan had just begun his senior year at Maynard High School and was preparing to live his dream of moving to Los Angeles to become a music producer.

Ronan was happiest when he was performing and creating music, and this talent was evident early on. At age two he belted out an impromptu “Oh Susannah” at his grandmother’s funeral services. At age seven he found Guitar Hero. When his Auntie Lanie bought him a red Squire Stratocaster beginner pack, Ronan played ‘up to eleven’ every day for the next ten years — eventually graduating up to his beloved purple PRS.

Ronan lived his life immersed in imagination. As a young child he mostly dressed in costume and played with props. As a teenager he also, well, dressed in costume and played with props, mastering his stage presence and musicality with unapologetic flamboyance and finesse. He was recognized for his achievements on guitar and picked up bass, keys and drums along the way. He recently founded his own music production and recording studio, under the name “RJ Beats”.

Ronan was both empathetic and precocious from an early age. He had a wise kindness beyond his years and the unique ability to make everyone around

him feel better, as though they belonged. He could hold a meaningful conversation with anyone of any generation or interest. Those who met him commented that they were fascinated by him and couldn't wait to see who he would become.

Ronan was always the light for those he loved. To his mom, he was her hero. To his dad, he was his partner. And to his sister, he was her best friend.

Ronan loved Nanna Days with his grandparents, talking about new bands with his Uncle Jamie, and snuggling with his Auntie RiRi. In his best friend Carter, he found the perfect music collaborator. Oh, and don't tell Abby but the family cat — Sargent Pepper — loved Ronan best.

Ronan's legacy will live on in his parents, Allison and Seth Jeannotte, and his beloved sister Abigail Jeannotte, of Maynard, MA. He also leaves behind his Nanna and Bup, James and Kathleen McGuigan of Lunenburg, MA; aunts and uncle, James and Korin McGuigan of Auburn, ME, Elena Jeannotte and Angie Shetler of Alexandria, VA, and Rachel Jeannotte of Acton, MA; as well as cousins Caelan, Evie, Asher, Lincoln and Leo. He was met in heaven by Grammie and Grampa Roy and Ann Marie Jeannotte. And is likely by now part of a heavenly super group with Juice WRLD and Randy Rhoads.

Ronan will be missed forever by his heartbroken parents, sister, extended family and friends. His valiant battle is complete.

Sweet boy, we have comfort in knowing that you are now at peace and your pain is gone. We are blessed that we can call you ours.
