



Stephen P. Marcoulier

February 23, 1961 - August 11, 2023

Ashby-Stephen P. Marcoulier, 62, of Ashby passed away Friday evening August 11, 2023 from injuries sustained in a motor vehicle accident in Mendon, Vermont.

He was born in Fitchburg on February 23, 1961 a son of the late J. Paul and Denise C. (L'Ecuyer) Marcoulier. He graduated from St. Bernard's High School in 1980 and attended Unity College in Maine.

Steve was a Project Manager for several companies, most recently for Act Glass in Newton, NH. He began his own successful company, Colony Glass Construction in 1985 and was a talented glazer, working on many projects throughout New England.

Steve was heavily involved in the communities he lived. He was a past member of the Phillipston Conservation Commission, served on the Narragansett Regional School Committee for 13 years as the Phillipston representative – including holding the chairmanship for several of those years. In 2007, he was awarded a lifetime achievement award from the Massachusetts Association of School Committees (MASC). He was a volunteer member of the Phillipston Fire Department, eventually becoming a licensed EMT working for Woods Ambulance in Gardner, MA and coached for the Narragansett Area Little League. Steve was a member of the Crotched

Mountain Ski Patrol, the Knights of Columbus, and a former member of the Royalston Rod and Gun Club. An active outdoorsman, Steve was the happiest spending time with family and friends while hiking, hunting, fishing, camping, or working on his small farm.

Steve leaves his wife, Caroline A. (Collins) Marcoulier of Ashby; two sons, Jason Marcoulier and his wife, Elizabeth of Quincy, and Jake Marcoulier of Boston; three brothers, Thomas Marcoulier, and his wife, Lori of Southborough, James Marcoulier, and his wife, Deborah of Leominster, and Brian Marcoulier of Sterling; a step son, Robert Napior, II, of Ocala, FL; his former wife, Katharina (Charpentier) Pfeiffer of Gardner and several uncles, aunts, nephews, and nieces.

His funeral Mass will be celebrated on Saturday, August 19 at 10 AM in St. Joseph's Church, 49 Woodland St., Fitchburg. Burial will be in St. Bernard's Cemetery in Fitchburg.
