Thomas H. Fadden, 68, of Townsend, died Friday, March 12, 2021 at his residence surrounded by friends and family. He was diagnosed with pancreatic cancer in February 2017, and with his faith in Jesus Christ is now resting with his Heavenly Father.

Thomas was born in Lowell, October 21, 1952, a son of the late Russell and Joan (Sheehan) Fadden and resided in Dracut before moving to Townsend 35 years ago. He attended Dracut High School and Lowell State College where he majored in History.

He leaves his wife of 42 years, Robin L. (Cathcart) Fadden; his son, Nicholas R. Fadden with his fiancée Rachael Deaktor of Lunenburg, his daughter, Kerri A. Fadden of Swampscott; three brothers, Daniel Fadden of Nashua, NH, John Fadden of Lowell, Scott Fadden of Dracut; two sisters, Mary Jo Cole of Tampa, FL, Karen Witts of Dracut; and three grandchildren Brynlee Fadden, Sarah O'Donnell and Willow Fadden. He was the brother of the late Nancy Fadden of Dracut.

Thomas worked as a machinist at Puritan Press in Hollis, NH retiring in 2017. He attended the First Baptist Church in West Townsend. He enjoyed reading, was a fan of the Boston Sports teams, an avid runner and competed in several races with his daughter. He formerly was an active member of the

Dunstable Church, where he served as a religious education teacher, youth leader, guest preacher, member of the music committee and a deacon.

Funeral services will be held 10 AM Tuesday, March 16, 2021 at the First Baptist Church, 461 Main Street, West Townsend. Burial will be in the Hillside Cemetery, Townsend.
