



Thomas S. Regan

July 27, 1944 - November 1, 2021

TOWNSEND: Thomas S. Regan, 77, a Townsend resident for nearly 50 years, died unexpectedly Monday, November 1, 2021 at Nashoba Valley Medical Center, Ayer.

His wife of 56 years, Dorothy V. "Bunny" (Mercer) Regan died this past May.

Mr. Regan was born in Cambridge, July 27, 1944 the son of George and Mary (Stanley) Regan and grew up in Lexington. He was a graduate of Lexington High School and was a standout hockey player there.

For over 30 years he worked as a tractor trailer driver for M.W. Leahy Company in Ayer retiring in 2000. Following his retirement he and his wife owned and operated Thornton Snowmobile Sales and Service in Thornton, NH.

A lifelong hockey enthusiast, Tom coached youth hockey for many years for several teams including the Fitchburg Wallopers and was instrumental in formation of the Pepperell Ashby Townsend Youth Hockey program. Starting at an early age Tom spent his summers at his family home in Deer Isle, ME.

He leaves his daughter and son in law, Kimberley J. and Brian Watson of Townsend; his son, Thomas S. Regan Jr. of Shirley; nine grandchildren,

Samantha Morris, Shayla Watson, Jessica Watson, Skye Gauthier, Lucas Gauthier, Drake Harris, Alton Harris, Christopher Regan and Makenzie Regan; two great grandchildren, John Morris Jr. and Mia Morris.

He was the father of the late Kelly Ann Regan – Gauthier of California who died in 2009 and was the brother of the late Marjorie Hammond of Virginia and Janet Glennon of Burlington.
