LEOMINSTER: Thomas C. "Slick" Wilson, Jr., 66, of Leominster, passed away on Tuesday January 24, 2023, at Tufts Medical Center in Boston.

Thomas was born in Pittsburg, Pennsylvania October 1, 1956, a son of the late Thomas C. Sr., and Mozeaner M. (Steals) Wilson and grew up in Ayer, graduating from Ayer High School in 1974.

He was a Sergeant for the Massachusetts Department of Corrections and during his 35 years of service, he worked as a Background Investigator and was a member of The SWAT Team. Tom recently retired from the Department of Corrections in 2020. Following his retirement, Thomas worked part-time as a delivery person for O'Reilly's Auto Parts.

Thomas was a God-fearing man, who loved spending time with his wife, family and friends. Tom enjoyed cooking, participating in the Boston Marathons, exercising, watching sports, especially boxing. He was affectionately known as "The Champ". He enjoyed collecting antiques and many other interests.

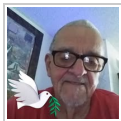
