June 18, 1988 - January 21, 2021

LITTLETON: Timothy D. Gibbons, 32, of Lunenburg, formerly of Littleton, died unexpectedly at his home, after a long struggle with epilepsy on Thursday, January 21, 2021.

Tim was born June 18, 1988, a son of Leo and Denise (LeBrun) Gibbons. He grew up in, and loved Littleton, MA. Two years ago, he purchased a home in Lunenburg. He graduated from Nashoba Valley Technical High School, where he studied to be an electrician and he enjoyed working in the field ever since.
