AYER — Vera E. (Rumpf) Nau, 79 of formerly of Ayer, died Saturday, September 28, 2019

Vera was born in Poland on December 15, 1939, and arrived in the United States from Europe as a young girl after losing her family in WWII.

She was adopted by the late Oscar and Alethea Rumpf of Lansdale, PA and attended the Pennsylvania School for the Deaf before moving to Missouri where she would graduate from the Missouri School of the Deaf in 1960, a great accomplishment for a displaced young lady.

In the mid 60's she and her husband moved to the the Virginia/Maryland area where she worked as a seamstress for the Kenfair Manufacturing Company in Virginia for 19 years prior to her retirement. While living there she was a member of the Maryland Washington Association for the Deaf.

In the late 90's she moved back to this area and enjoyed living in Ayer being close to her children and grandchildren. She also loved her cats, tortoises and thriving house plants.

She leaves her three daughters, Lila E. Reader of Rockland, and Julia S. Alekman and Minnie A. Cahill, both of Ayer; three grandchildren, Jeremy Dean

Cahill, Erik Cahill and Casey Alekman; her brothers, Michael Wolkow of Australia, Bill Rumpf and David Rumpf both of Wisconsin and Bob Rumpf of Germany, nephews and nieces.

She is predeceased by her husband, Ronald F. Nau and a son, Mischa F. Nau.

A graveside service will be held on Saturday, October 26, at 11AM in the in the Woodlawn Cemetery in Ayer. There are no calling hours.
