Townsend - Virginia F. (Freeman) Welch, 98, of Townsend passed away on Friday evening, August 9, 2024, in the Highlands in Fitchburg.

Ginny was born on October 8, 1925, in Lunenburg and raised by her adoptive parents Franklin A. and Lillian (Bosworth) Freeman. She graduated from Lunenburg High School with the class of 1943.

She was Executive Secretary to the Superintendent of Schools of the Union # 24, which included Ashby, Lunenburg and Townsend school systems. In 1954 she became the Executive Secretary to the Superintendent of Schools in the Lunenburg Public School system and worked there for 42 years before her retirement in 1986.

She enjoyed music, movies, scrapbooking, gardening, crocheting, craft fairs, and last, but not least, loved all the cats in her life as well as her three Newfoundland's.

She is predeceased by her husband, Robert A. Welch, who passed away in 2002. She leaves a sister Barbara A. 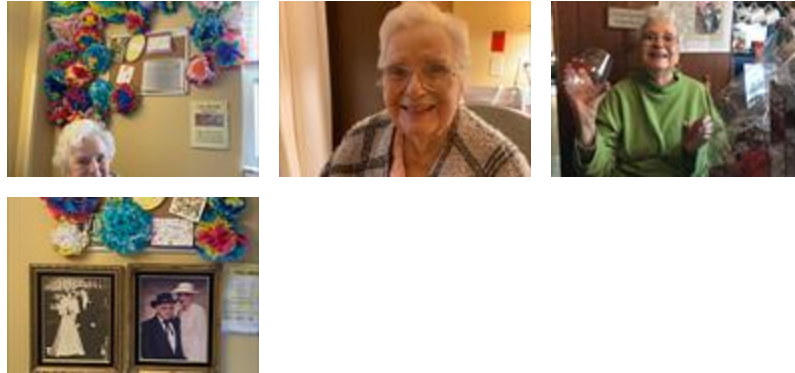
