Townsend: Warren Minter McFague, 89, of Townsend, died Saturday, December 8, 2018 at Health Alliance- Leominster Hospital.

Mr. McFague was born in Medford, January 17, 1929, one of seven children born to James and Marilyn (Brooke) McFague and resided in Townsend for 54 years.

He graduated from Medford High School where he was a three sport captain and inducted into the sports Hall of Fame. He attended Georgetown University before graduating from Western Maryland College. He continued his education at the Industrial College of the Armed Forces in Washington DC.

During the Korean Conflict Mr. McFague served his country in the United States Army.

He leaves his wife of 38 years, Norma Jean (Anna) McFague; a son and daughter in law, Adam C. and Cheryl McFague of Townsend; three daughters and sons in law, Vaune E. and Russ Larned of Enumclaw, WA, Holly L. and Terry Schrepfer of Lexington, KY, Heather C. and Richard Clement of Sudbury. He also leaves nine grandchildren.

His first wife, Mary Alice (Amoss) McFague died in 1977.

Mr. McFague held the position of Deputy Regional Director Health & Human Services in Boston before retiring in 1992. He served many years as a Trustee at North Middlesex Savings Bank in Ayer. He was known for his Irish wit, generosity, love of his family and all creatures great and small. Most especially his grandchildren: Trevor, Elizabeth, Conner, Gunnar, Garrett, Anna, Bradley, Molly and Seamus.

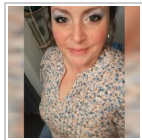
